
Topic: Grammar-Articles & Prepositions

SUMMARY OF THE DISCUSSION:



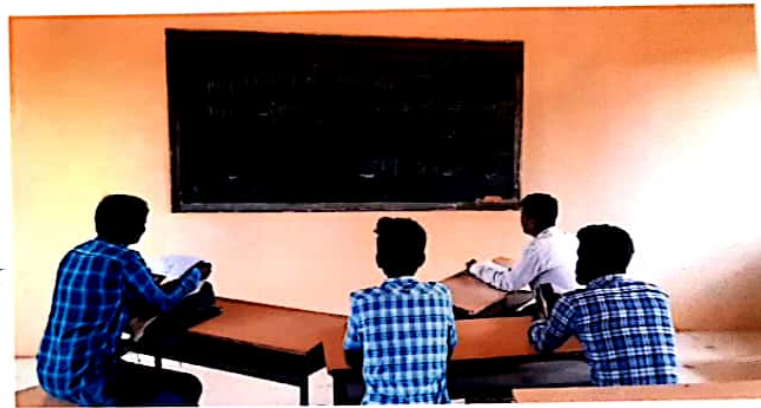
TOPIC: Akbar - Din-e-Illahi Religion


