Shri Sharana Nooliya Chandayya (Chandeswaralinga) Back to Index *Kāyaka* (Occupation): Rope maker (out of grass or straw) Nooliya Chandayya was a Kaayakayogi who made rope out of grass or straw (rope maker). He belonged to a place called Shivanagi in Bijapur district Karnataka. In the Shoonyasampadane and other puranas there is a description of his loyalty to the work. He was a prominent member of the Anubhava Mantapa. He made the Ishtalinga sell the rope.

As a story goes, while washing hanks of grass fibre in a stream, his Ishtalinga fell into water. Then Chandayya turned indifferent to the Linga which had dropped off his Anga, and refused to take him back even when the Linga implored him to accept. However, Chandayya accepted the Linga on the condition that 'He' should help him in his Kayaka to which the Linga readily agreed and carried Chandayya's ropes to the market for selling.

Hendad Marayya (another sharana) has dramatically portrayed in one of his vachanas about Chandayya's great personality. Chandayya went to Uluvi with Chennabasavanna after the revolution of Kalyaana. After Chennabasavanna's death he takes Akkanagamma to the banks of Yennahole where she died. He died at Nulenuru. His 48 vachanas are extant with the signature Chandeshwara.

All the vachanas uphold the rule of Kaayaka as compulsory to guru, linga and jangama. "Even for a guru Kaayaka gives liberation...., Even for Jangama kaayaka cuts the bond of pretension" are his words and they are examples of the importance he was attached to kaayaka

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligibility for Admission:

- 1) No candidate will be admitted to the First Year of the Three Year BA/ B.Com. Degree Course, unless he/she has passed the two year Pre University Examination of the Pre-University Educational Board, Karnataka or an Examination equivalent to.
- 2) The students seeking admission to B.A/ B.Com. shall visit the college office and collect the admission form. The required documents to be submitted should be produced by the students seeking admission in the college.



UNIVERSITY RULES

- Attendance is compulsory. Each student should have a minimum of 75 % attendance to appear for the semester examination.
- Each student has to face two internal test in each semester which is compulsory.
- Each student should submit assignment as it is compulsory.

COLLEGE DISCIPLINARY RULES

1. The students should follow the rules and regulations issued by the college from time to time, failing which they will be penalized or disciplinary action will be taken against them.
2. The students must carry the Identity cards issued by the College with them and produce the same whenever they are demanded by any member of the staff. The students who do not possess these identity cards will not be allowed to enter the class rooms, library and examination hall. The identity cards must have a stamp size photograph of the students and must bear the Principal's signature.
3. Students should attend all the classes compulsorily. They have to attend a minimum of 75% of the total number of periods engaged in each subject. Otherwise they will not be eligible to appear for the semester Examination.
4. Students should not indulge in any such activities either in the premises or outside the college which will affect the general administration and discipline of the college.
5. Students are not permitted to act indecently or involve in any unruly activity with his/her fellow classmates or any other students.
6. Prior written permission from the principal is required for
 - holding a meeting in the college
 - collecting funds for any purpose
 - arranging any excursion/tour
7. Students should maintain a sense of decorum at all times both inside and outside the college. Those who are found guilty of serious misconduct may invite punishment including expulsion as permitted by regulations
8. Scribbling on walls or desks, loitering on the campus, defacing in the building is reprehensible and will attract punishment.
9. Students are advised to see the notice board regularly for important announcements.
10. Students should not entertain any outsider in the college or invite members of any Student Organization without the permission of the principal.
